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Missouri Businesses Receive \$800,000 for Safety Initiatives

MEM plans to award at least \$1 million in safety grants over three years

Columbia, MO—The frequency of workers compensation claims continues to decline in Missouri, but Missouri Employers Mutual won't stop until workplace injuries are eliminated. The Safety Fanatics at MEM awarded the company's fourth round of safety grants to Missouri businesses this month to help them take the next step toward improving workplace safety.

To date, MEM has awarded a total of 86 policyholders with nearly \$800,000 in safety grants, and plans to give away a total of at least \$1 million in order to improve workplace safety.
