Protect yourself against job hazards.

- Keep PPE clean, available and ready.
- Know how to obtain replacement PPE.

- Wear protective footwear when near falling or rolling objects.
- Wear slip-on ice cleats when working in ice or snow.
- Wear high-visibility garments when working near traffic.
