

Near Miss Reporting Form

A “near miss” is any “close call” that you have experienced or witnessed involving a machine, tool, process or equipment. Near misses DO NOT result in injury or damage but are clearly a problem that should be addressed. Employees usually do not feel the need to report because they do not result in damage, injury, repairs or dollar loss. They may also feel that near misses will lead to disciplinary action, investigations or embarrassment. But they are very important because our company and crews can learn from them and prevent future incidents.

Please write down and share the “close call” that you experienced or saw. This information helps our company improve safety efforts and training. You don’t have to share your name if you have concerns about how this information will be used.
